



### **Claudio COLOSIO's Short CV**

Prof. Claudio Colosio is a medical doctor and PhD in occupational health and safety. He is currently Associate Professor of Occupational Health at the Department of Health Sciences of the University of Milan and Scientific Coordinator of the International Centre for Rural Health of the Hospital San Paolo of Milano, World Health Organization Collaborating Centre in Occupational Health. His main research interests are in the field of Occupational Health and Rural and Agricultural Medicine. Additional research interests are occupational toxicology, with a particular attention for pesticides and pesticide related issues.

Prof. Colosio has participated, both as a component and as Coordinator, in several projects of national and international research, and currently is engaged in collaborative EU research projects and Tempus programmes. He has been member of the Advisory Committee on Pesticides of the Italian Ministry of Health, of the Working Group "Farmworkers and pesticides" of ANSES (Agence Nationale Française de Sécurité Sanitaire de l'alimentation, de l'environnement et du Travail). He is past president and secretary of the Scientific Committee on Rural Health of the International Commission of Occupational Health (ICOH) and Vice-President of the International Association of Agricultural Medicine and Rural Health. One of the main activities he is nowadays coordinating is the definition of experiences addressed at improving the access into health care systems of disadvantaged populations, in particular living and working in rural and remote areas. In this field, he has participated in 2011 in the Den Haag global Conference "Connecting Health and Labour. What Role for Occupational Health in Primary Health Care" and in 2014 in the international Consultation "Caring for all working people: Interventions, Indicators and Service Delivery" organized by WHO in Senman (Islamic Republic of Iran). He is the author of over 100 papers published on peer reviewed journals, chapters of textbooks and author of more than 200 presentations at national and international Congresses. He acted as teacher in national and international training courses and is holder of occupational medicine and health teaching in undergraduate and postgraduate courses in Occupational Medicine, as well as refreshing courses for GPs.
