Dr Jovanka Karadzinska Bislimovska is a permanent full professor of occupational health and she is the Head of Chair of Occupational Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, University "St. Cyril and Methodius, Skopje, R. Macedonia. Bislimovska works in the Institute of Occupational Health of RM as the Head of Department for research, education and international cooperation and she is the Director of WHO Collaborating Center for Occupational Health at the Institute, since 2003.

Prof. Bislimovska is the responsible teacher for subjects Occupational medicine / Occupational health for undergraduate, master and doctoral studies at the Faculty of Medicine, University "St. Cyril and Methodius, Skopje.

Her scientific field of expertise is focused on occupational health and public health, and her special research interest is related to different aspects of workers health (vulnerable groups of workers - unemployed, agricultural workers, healthcare workers; psychosocial risk factors, occupational respiratory and allergic diseases, OH system and policy etc.).

Bislimovska has published more than 150 papers in international and national journals, and she is author and editor of monographs, manuals and university textbooks ("Allergology", 2018 ; "Occupational Health", 2012; "Law and Public Health", 2009; "Public Health Glossary", 2006) in the field of occupational health and public health.

During her professional carrier, Prof. Bislimovska realized a many academic study visits and international fellowships (SIDA, Stokskholm, Sweden, 2000; Oxford University, Oxford, UK, 2001 ; Hebrew University-Hadassah, Jerusalem, Israel, 2005; Finish Institute of Occupational Health, Helsinki, Finland, 2005; University of Milan- Universita degli Studi di Milano, Milan, Italy, 2015 etc).



During her 37 years experienced work, Prof.Bislimovska participated as a team leader, coordinator, program manager, WHO and EC consultant in many projects and programs in the field of occupational and public health, at national and international level.

Prof.Bislimovska is actual coordinator of Southeast European Network on Workers' Health (SEENWH) as a regional expert's network that collaborate with WHO/Europe on occupational health issues.
